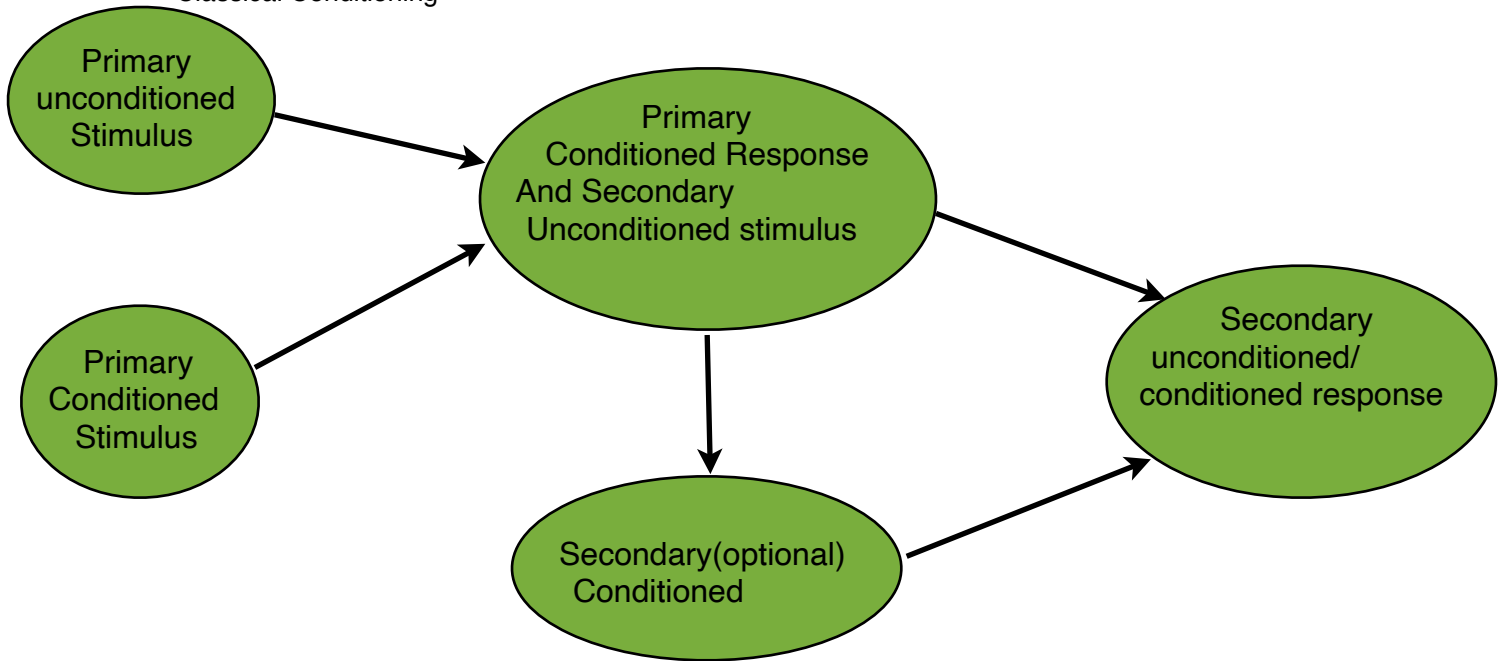
Unconditioned Response - Salivating

Classical Conditioning



Given the above approach, is it possible to induce the secondary response from the secondary conditioned stimulus without preceding with the primary stimulus? Essentially, is the primary stimulus an argument for the secondary conditioned stimulus to induce the secondary response.

One associates the unconditioned stimulus with the conditioned stimulus in an attempt to yield the conditioned response with simply the conditioned stimulus. An important question in deciding whether or not this secondary cascade is possible is to decide whether or not the unconditioned response and the conditioned response are different.
